the days, weeks and months following the loss of a baby can be painful and difficult to live through. The care team encourages you not to stay alone.


The Ceremony of Stars commemorates and honours the babies who died at the start of their lives. The ceremony takes place on the first Saturday of October every year.

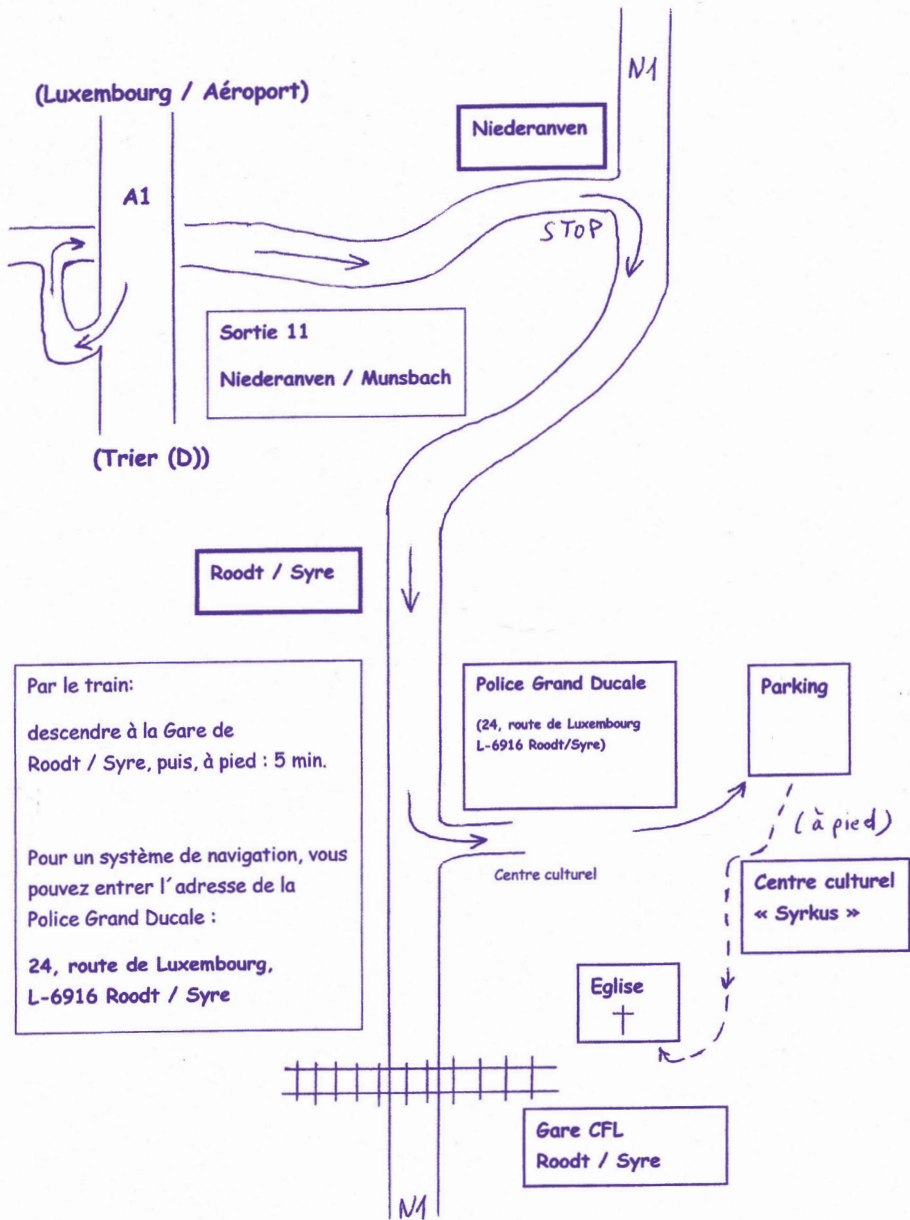
